



PARK RULES AND POLICIES

Office Hours: 9:00 – 5:30pm daily, however these may vary depending on peak and off-peak times.

Check-in time: 1pm

Check-out time: 10am - if you're arrival or departure times are different to these, please speak with reception.

- Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee particular numbered sites and cabins.
- All accommodation tariffs to be paid in advance and are not refundable after check-in.
- Only one car per site. If you would like to bring any other vehicles, or personal leisure equipment (eg: boats, motorbikes etc.), this is at the discretion of the park management and must be approved prior to arrival. Vehicles are not to be driven over or parked on a vacant site.
- New arrivals and guest must report to the office before entry to the park. Guests are responsible for their visitor's behaviour. Please ensure all visitors have vacated the park by 10pm unless otherwise agreed with park management.
- Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes and rubbish disposal. Everyone appreciates a well-kept site, so please remember that we do not allow trenches to be dug in the park under any circumstances.
- No fires are permitted within the grounds of the caravan park unless approved by management.
- Trees around the park are inspected regularly, however trees and branches may still fall from time to time. Persons entering the park do so at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for personal, or property damage caused by falling trees or branches.
- For the comfort of all guest, no undue noise is permitted between 10:00pm and 8:00am. Music and TV's should not be audible to adjoining sites. Parents are responsible for ensuring their children do not disturb the peace and quiet of other park guests. Excessive noise and rowdy behaviour will result in eviction from these premises. Excessive use of alcohol is an unacceptable condition of your stay.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the showers, toilets and camp kitchen.

- In the interest of safety, the speed limit is always walking pace throughout the park (10km p/h maximum)
- Park management must be notified at the time of booking if you wish to bring your pet to ensure they comply with our guidelines.
- All persons enter the park at their own risk and are responsible for their possessions and vehicles.
- Generators are not allowed in the park unless approved by management.
- Drinking water is available on your power pole.
- The camp kitchen is available for all guests. Please clean BBQ's, kitchen appliances and utensils after use.
- The park utilises a septic toilet system. Only toilet paper supplied by the park and human waste can be put down the toilets. Any persons found disposing of unauthorised items may incur the costs involved for pumping out or repairing the septic system.
- Any person found to be damaging park property or that of other guests will be evicted from the park and will be held responsible for repair costs. Additional cleaning costs are applicable if cabins are not left in a clean and tidy state when you check-out.
- Prices, rules and policies are subject to change without notice. Park management reserves the right to evict any person who fails to obey the park rules.

DOG POLICY

- Maximum of two (2) dogs are permitted per booking.
- Dogs must be supervised at all times and never left unattended, including inside vans.
- When in the park, dogs must be kept on a leash and under your control at all times.
- Dogs are not permitted in cabins or in any communal areas (eg: camp kitchen, amenities block, etc.).
- As the owner of the dog, you are responsible for the cleaning up after your pet which also includes toilet duties!
- No barking, yapping or aggressive behaviour allowed.
- Should you wish to wash any dog bedding, please ONLY use the designated washing machine (located behind male amenities block). Cleaning fees will apply should you use any of the other washing machines.
- Walkamin Caravan Park management reserves the right to disallow any pet at the caravan park that they deem not appropriate to stay at the park.
- All dog owners, whether you have expressly agreed or not, assume all liability regarding your dog being on our premises and indemnify Walkamin Caravan Park against all and any damages, all or any claims or other suits that may arise as a result of your dog being anywhere in our caravan park. Any breaches of the above conditions could result in early departure and forfeit of refund.
